A native of Taipei, Taiwan, Chan has adopted the Alamo City, and her commitment to San Antonio is unquestionable.

She and her husband, Clifford Hew, founded Unintech Consulting Engineers Inc in 1992 and from one employee it now employs upwards of 50 people.

The company has been successful and on a number of occasions has been recognized as among the "Top 25 Largest Engineering" and "Women-Owned" companies in San Antonio.
